Executive Summary



In 2024, Eduvision Ghana moved from a promising start to a proven organisation. In just our second year of operation, we ran five major programmes, launched a landmark Tech for Girls Summit, trained 100 women in enterprise skills, and entered our first AI literacy partnership.

Our work in 2024 showed us something important: that impact scales when you stay rooted in community. Every programme we delivered was built around what girls and women in the Northern Region actually need — not what looks good on paper.

The Tech for Girls Summit was a defining moment. Seeing girls from across the region on one stage, asking bold questions about their futures in science and technology, reminded us why this work matters every single day.

We are grateful to our partners — SAN, Zaa Radio, GDG Tamale, and Women TechMakers Tamale — and to every participant who chose to invest their time in learning, growing, and leading. 2024 is proof that the Northern Region is ready for a STEM revolution.



Capacity Building and Training



Eduvision Ghana delivered its most ambitious training calendar yet. 100 women participated in Soap Making entrepreneurship training in partnership with SAN (March 2024), equipping them with production skills and business knowledge for micro-enterprise.

Web Development Training 2.0 (April 2024) advanced participants from foundational to applied skills, covering responsive design, CMS platforms, and freelancing. The ExperienceAI programme introduced girls to artificial intelligence concepts and career pathways in a landmark AI literacy initiative.

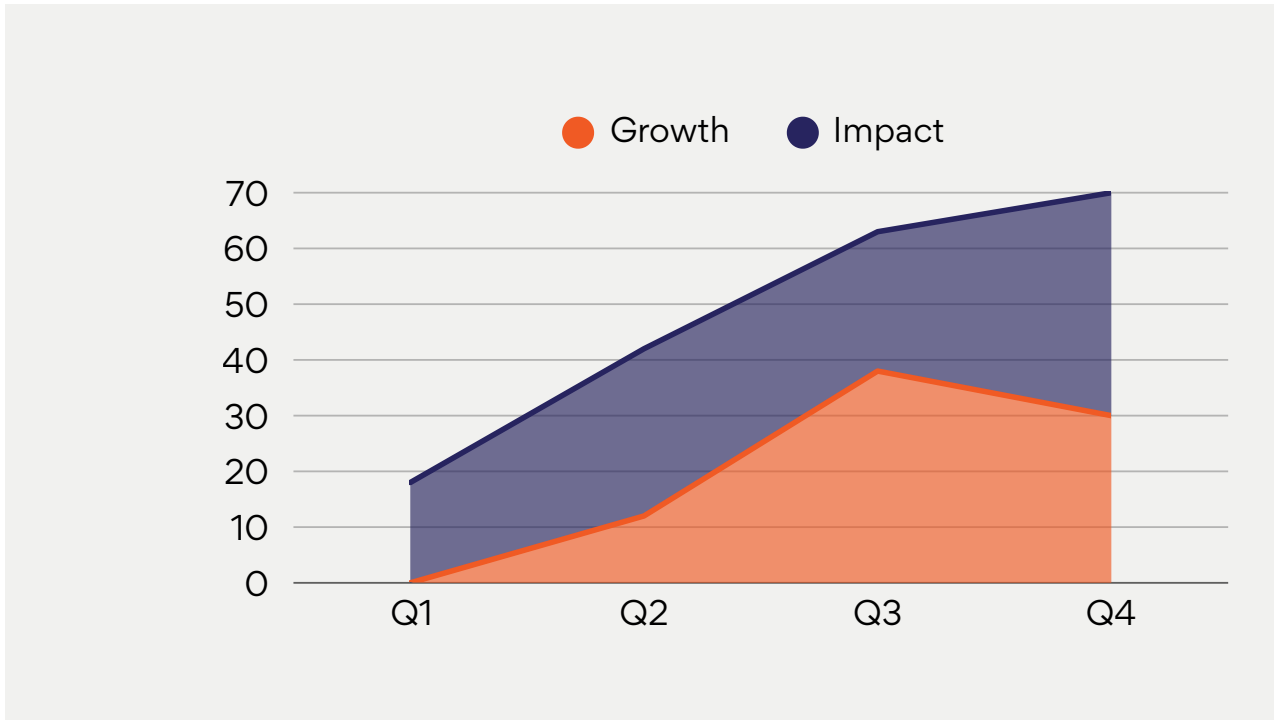
Policy Engagement and Advocacy
